



Superpine – a single tree, a singular shelf

Our Superpine shelving system is a tribute to the mighty silver fir trees (*Abies alba*) native to the Bregenzerwald. One of the great advantages of silver fir is that it can be used to produce large, unglued boards. The Superpine shelving system – made of silver fir and blackened steel – elevates this potential.

Each of the two materials used does what it can do best: Slender steel columns with straps structure the vertical, while solid silver fir boards provide shelf space and create the horizontal. The material combination of steel and silver fir exhibits high stability with minimal dead weight.

The Superpine shelving system can be realised in lengths of up to 4 metres. Specific prices are available on request.

Those who prefer a different material aesthetic will find a suitable alternative in the Superstructure shelving system.
